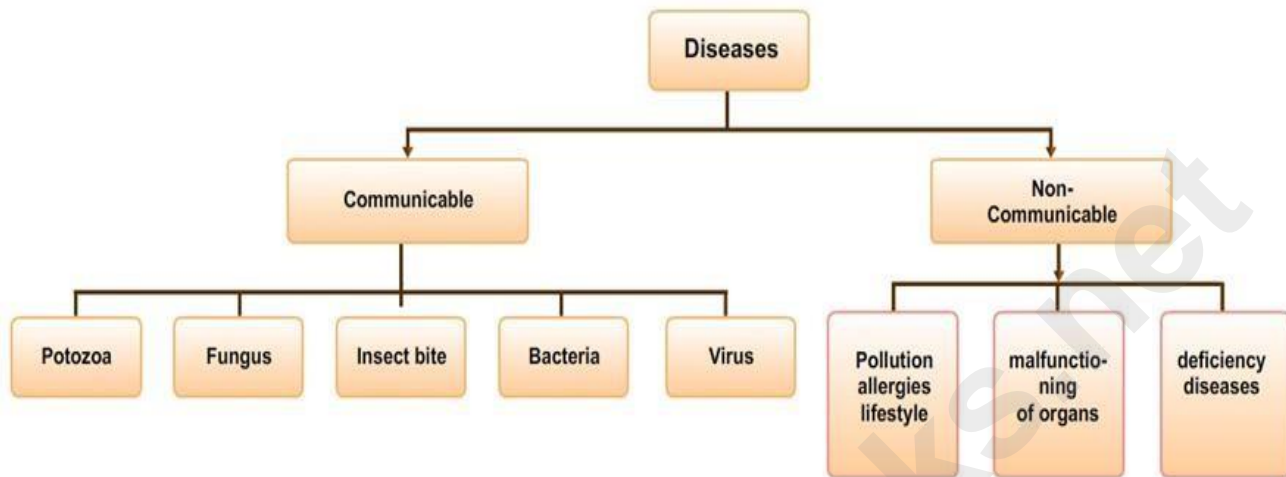

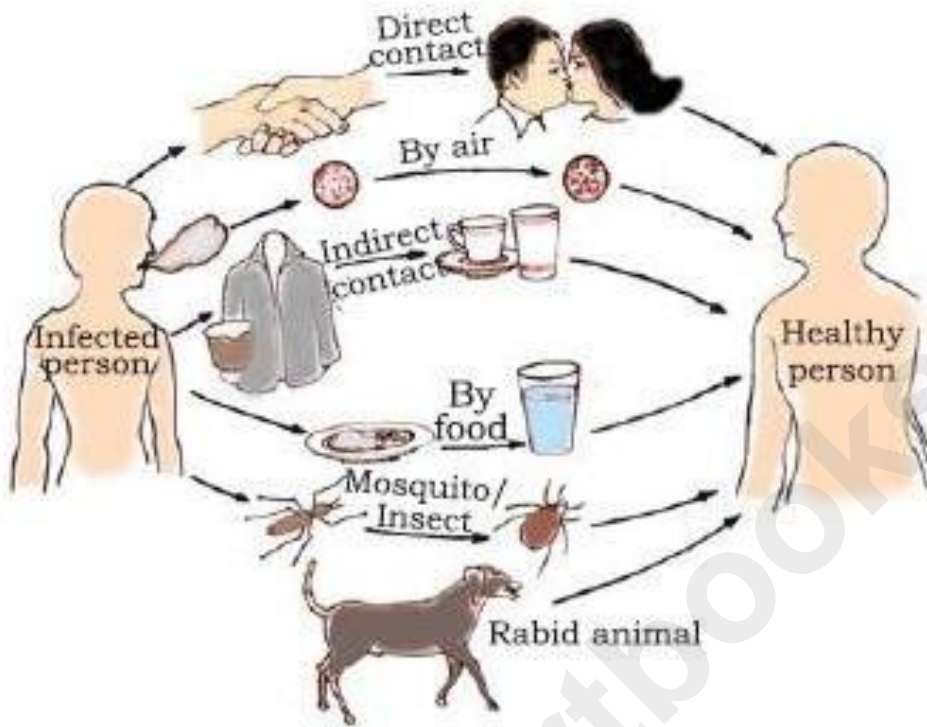
COMMON DEFICIENCY DISEASES

	Rickets, osteomalacia		Muscular pain, dehydration, low response to stimuli





Prevention of diseases

FIRST AID

Cuts (PAW)	Bites (BAT)	Stings (SAI)	Burns (CCC)
 <p>Wash the area with soap and water Apply antiseptic Press the area with a clean cloth if there is bleeding</p>	 <p>A Tourniquet can be applied to the area above the bite The Bite should be washed A doctor should be consulted without delay to administer Anti rabies or anti venom injection</p>	 <p>The Sting should be carefully removed Anti-histamine may be given to reduce swelling Ice pack can be applied</p>	 <p>Cool the area under running water Cover with loose non-sticky dressing Call the ambulance for third degree burns</p>
